

Pick-up schedule for students' personal belongings and end of year materials

All BCS teachers and support staff have been putting together personal items that belong to each student in their classroom. Additionally, other end of the year materials and supplies have been added with the personal belongings. These items have all been placed in individual bags and are ready for pick-up and in many cases may already have been delivered by classroom teachers. However please note, that if your child ordered Square 1 Art and/or a yearbook, these items may still be at school.

I have scheduled times next week for parents/guardians to start picking-up individual student bags. I realize that these times may not fit all family schedules and based on the results of this first attempt, will schedule additional times the following week. If necessary, I will schedule some early evening times to accommodate as many different family situations as possible.

Please note: If your child(ren) has library books or other school items at home, please drop these books and items off when picking up student belongings. We will have a box available for the library books.

Schedule for picking up student belongings for next week:

Monday, June 8th:

- Grades PreK & K students: 9:00 - 10:00 a.m.
- Grades 1 & 2 students: 10:00 - 11:00 a.m.
- Grade 3 students: 12:00 - 1:00 p.m.
- Grade 4 students: 1:00 – 2:00 p.m.

Tuesday, June 9th:

- Same schedule as June 8th for anyone that was unable to come in on June 8th.

Grade 5 will be able to pick up their belongings at the drive through promotion ceremony scheduled for June 10th. You should have received information regarding this event.

If you have more than one child enrolled at BCS, we will have all of your children's' belongings available for you at the time designated for pick-up for your youngest child. If that does not work for you, please call the main office.

We ask that you use the vehicle entrance designated as the drop-off/pick-up loop located by the cafeteria. We will have student bags on tables in the cafeteria and someone will be available to bring the bag(s) to a table at curbside for you. Once the bag is on the table, please have only one person leave the vehicle to take the bag from the table. The adults bringing student bags to the curbside table will wear masks and gloves. We are making every effort to follow safety protocol when transitioning student bags, and we ask that you please not leave vehicles to socialize during the scheduled pick-up time.

Thank you for your help and cooperation with this. We will do whatever we can to help you with this process.

Sadly, we have had to let go of many wonderful school traditions and experiences this spring. However, recognizing our students before they leave for summer break is not one that we wanted to let go of. All of our students have touched the lives of many while being here at BCS this school year and the administration and staff want to wish them all well before they leave our building for summer break. Traditionally, at the end of the school year, the entire BCS staff sits in the bus loop and waves to all our students as they leave for summer break. Obviously, this cannot happen this year, however, we do have an alternative plan.

On Thursday June 18th from 5:00-6:00 all BCS staff that can attend will line the drop-off/pick-up loop at BCS. All students and parents are invited to drive through the loop so that we can carry on our tradition and wave to our students for the last time to celebrate the end of school year 2020. All staff will keep social distancing and we ask that parents slowly drive around the loop without stopping and/or leaving their cars. Some traditions just cannot be lost! Hopefully, you can attend for this drive through event, and we look forward to seeing you.
